**DATES:** From January 10<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> 2022. Local teams will start playing as of Monday January 10th. Out of town teams will be expected to play during the day on Friday, January 14th starting from 11 am. See last year's schedule on our website for the pattern of game hours.

**RULES:** Official Ringette Canada rules will be in effect. Therefore, the "any-three-in" and "30-second" rules will be played for U12 Atom/Petite age and over (and Novice A). However, the "no zone" rule will be in effect for teams in U8 and U10. No shot clock for U10 and younger. U8 will be following the new Ringette Quebec rules and guidelines developed for Children's Ringette i.e. half ice, 4 on 4 with the use of mini nets (see details in the U8 protocol on the BKRA website).

**REGISTRATION:** Applications are to be completed via the online registration and online payment system at [www.ringettebk.ca](http://www.ringettebk.ca) starting September 1<sup>st</sup> until November 30<sup>th</sup>. We must receive **both** your official registration and your online payment in order to confirm your team's participation. **We accept Interac e-Transfers for no additional charge.** Credit card payments are accepted, a transaction fee of 3% applies.

**NO ENTRANCE FEE:** All admission fees are covered by your team's registration fee. Entry to the arenas will be free to all. Overall, this represents a net savings for each team (11 players x 2 parents x \$5 admission = \$110).

**Hotel booking:** *all away teams are expected to make their hotel reservations with one of our partner hotels listed below. Book directly with the hotel contact person indicating clearly that you are with the BKRA tournament (no online booking or travel agency).*
